What is Money skills for life?

Money skills for life is a free one-hour personal finance talk, developed by the Competition and Consumer Protection Commission (CCPC) to provide financial education to employees, with the support of their employer. Talks are delivered by volunteer presenters trained by the CCPC and each attendee gets a free handbook, which contains lots of useful information and tools to help them manage their money. The talk covers six topics:

- Sorting out your money
- Saving and investing
- Insurance
- **Borrowing money**
- Dealing with debt
- Planning for later life

Since 2012 the programme has successfully reached over 25,000 employees in public and private sector organisations throughout the country. Talks have been delivered in a wide variety of organisations to groups of five to over 200.
