## **MERGER ANNOUNCEMENT**

## Competition and Consumer Protection Commission clears proposed acquisition by NAC Turbo Limited of Aldus Aviation Limited

## 17 May 2016

The Competition and Consumer Protection Commission has today cleared the proposed transaction whereby NAC Turbo Limited would acquire the entire issued share capital and, thus, sole control of Aldus Aviation Limited. The proposed transaction was notified under the Competition Act 2002 on 13 April 2016.

The Commission has formed the view that the proposed transaction will not substantially lessen competition in any market for goods or services in the State. The Commission will publish the reasons for its determination on its website no later than 60 working days after the date of the determination and after allowing the parties the opportunity to request that confidential information be removed from the published version.

## **Additional Information**

NAC Turbo Limited is a limited liability company incorporated in the State which is primarily active in the leasing of aircraft to airlines worldwide.

Aldus Aviation Limited is incorporated in the State and involved in the provision of aircraft lease management services.
