Role of Product Safety Unit


Unsafe non-food consumer products can cause accidents, injuries and in extreme cases, deaths

Our Primary Aim – Preventing Harm from Unsafe Products and so protect consumers from unsafe non-food consumer products

- Ensure products comply with legislation
- Investigate complaints



Business Obligations

Place only safe products on the market

- Unsafe products
 - Withdraw
 - Recall
 - -Inform CCPC



Economic Operators

- Toys and Low Voltage include definitions of Economic Operators and each has similar specific obligations under the regulations
 - Manufacturer
 - Importer
 - Distributor
- LVD Increased enforcement powers & market surveillance (from 765/2008)



- Ultimate responsibility for the conformity of the product
- Designed and manufactured in accordance with safety objectives
- draw up the required technical documentation
- carrying out conformity assessment
- draw up the EU Declaration of Conformity
- Affix CE Marking



- type, batch or serial number or other element allowing its identification
- (1) name
 - (2) registered trade name or registered trade mark
 - (3) a single contact postal address
- instructions & safety information
- sample testing



- If considers or has reason to believe product not in conformity
 - Immediately take corrective action to bring product into conformity
 - Where it presents a risk, inform the competent authority – provide details of the non-compliances and corrective measures



- Further to reasoned request from competent authority
 - Provide all the information and documentation necessary to demonstrate conformity
 - Co-operate in any action taken to eliminate the risk



- Shall not place product on market unless it complies with the regulations
- before placing a product on the market ensure
- Manufacturer has complied with their duties
 - conformity assessment
 - drawn up the technical documentation
 - affixed the relevant conformity marking (e.g. CE marking)
 - fulfilled traceability obligations product



- Manufacturer has complied with their duties
 - fulfilled traceability obligations
 - instructions and safety information
- Indicate Importer's name, registered trade name of registered trademark and the postal address
- Carry out sample testing



- Register of complaints, non-conforming, products and details of products recalls
- Inform distributor
- Bring product into conformity, withdraw or recall
- Inform competent authorities



- For 10 years after product placed on market
 - Copy Declaration of Conformity
 - Technical documentation
 - Further to reasoned request from competent authority, provide all information and documentation necessary to demonstrate conformity
 - Co-operate with competent authority on any action taken to eliminate risks



Distributor

- Only supply compliant products.
- Verify has CE mark
- Accompanied by the required documentation, instructions and markings including identification of the manufacturer and/or importer
- Safety information (correct language)



Distributor

- Ensure that storage and transport conditions do not jeopardise conformity of the equipment
- Inform the relevant national authorities if non conforming product presents a risk
- Take any corrective measure required to bring into conformity, recall or withdraw it from the market, if appropriate, are taken



Distributor

- Provide information or documentation in paper or electronic form if requested.
- Co-operate with authorities on any action to eliminate the risks posed by CE marked equipment which they have placed on the market.



Manufacturer obligations apply if

 Importer or distributor places product on market under importer or distributor's name or trademark

 Modifies product so that compliance with regulations may be affected

Product Safety Standards

- Measure conformity to essential safety requirements as required under the Directives
- Presumed to be in conformity
- Harmonised Standards
- NSAI



General Product Safety Directive

- Does not apply to a product subject to specific safety requirements imposed by a regulation of the Community or legislation giving effect to a directive of the Community
- Duties for producer & distributor
- Inform if 'on the basis of information in his or her possession and as a professional, ought to know...' poses a risk to the consumer



General Product Safety Directive

Recall

Withdraw

Prohibit placing on the market

No CE mark



General Product Safety Directive

- Wide variety of products not covered in the sector specific legislation
 - furniture
 - Child and child care articles
 - Candles
 - Children's clothing (cords & drawstrings)
 - Window blinds
 - Cigarette lighters



Toys

- Products designed or intended for use in play by children under 14 years of age
- Warnings
- Chemicals
- CE mark







Low Voltage Directive

- Electrical Equipment
 - 50-1000 volts (AC)
 - 75-1500 (DC)



- Designed & manufactured in accordance with safety objectives
- Manufacturer details / trademark
- Documentation
- CE Mark



Gas Appliances

- Appliances
 - Cooking, Heating,
 Hot water production, Refrigeration,
 Lighting, Washing
- CE mark
- Update







PPE

- Device or appliance designed to be worn or held by an individual for protection against one or more health and safety risks
- Leisure and recreation
- Basic health and safety requirements
- CE mark
- Update












 Indicates that product meets essential requirements of the relevant Directive





































- Affixed by the manufacturer once they have completed the conformity assessment
- CE Certificate Not same or equivalent to Declaration of Conformity
- Declaration must be drawn up by manufacturer


