



MERGER ANNOUNCEMENT - M/20/030

Competition and Consumer Protection Commission clears proposed acquisition by Lissan Coal Company (Ireland) Limited of sole control of Campus Oil Retail Limited

17 November 2020

The Competition and Consumer Protection Commission has cleared the proposed transaction whereby Lissan Coal Company (Ireland) Limited a wholly-owned subsidiary of LCC Group Holdings Limited, would acquire sole control of Campus Oil Retail Limited, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Campus Oil Holdings Limited. The proposed transaction was notified under the Competition Act 2002, as amended, on 12 October 2020.

The Commission has formed the view that the proposed transaction will not substantially lessen competition in any market for goods or services in the State. The Commission will publish the reasons for its determination on its website no later than 60 working days after the date of the determination and after allowing the parties the opportunity to request that confidential information be removed from the published version.

Additional Information

Lissan Coal Company (Ireland) Limited is an Irish private company limited by shares and a wholly-owned subsidiary of LCC Group Limited, which is a private limited company registered in Northern Ireland. The core activities of the LCC Group are within the coal, oil, electricity, gas and oil storage sectors.

Campus Oil Retail Limited is an Irish private company limited by shares, which currently carries on the business of the sale of motor fuels (petrol and diesel) to motorists and commercial vehicles, a car wash business, and the sale of food and convenience goods. Campus Oil Retail Limited is a subsidiary of Campus Oil Holdings Limited.
