

MERGER ANNOUNCEMENT M/25/028 – MAXOL / GLYNN'S SERVICE STATION

Section 21 of the Competition Act 2002

Competition and Consumer Protection Commission clears proposed acquisition whereby Maxol Limited would acquire sole control of Glynn's Service Station Limited.

The Competition and Consumer Protection Commission has cleared the proposed transaction whereby Maxol Limited would acquire sole control of Glynn's Service Station Limited. The proposed transaction was notified under the Competition Act 2002, as amended, on 7 April 2025.

The Commission has formed the view that the proposed transaction will not substantially lessen competition in any market for goods or services in the State. The Commission will publish the reasons for its determination on its website no later than 60 working days after the date of the determination and after allowing the parties the opportunity to request that confidential information be removed from the published version.

Additional Information

Maxol Limited is a subsidiary of Maxol Energy Limited, which in turn is a wholly owned subsidiary of McMullan Bros. Limited. Maxol's primary business in the State is in the provision of oil and petroleum products.

Glynn's Service Station Limited owns and operates a single service station with an attached forecourt convenience store located at Carnmore, approximately 9km east of Galway city.
