

MERGER ANNOUNCEMENT M/25/042 – FIS/TSYS

Competition and Consumer Protection Commission clears proposed acquisition whereby Fidelity National Information Services, Inc. would acquire sole control of Total System Services LLC

21 November 2025

The Competition and Consumer Protection Commission has today cleared the proposed transaction whereby Fidelity National Information Services Inc., would acquire sole control of Total System Services LLC, a subsidiary of Global Payments, Inc. The proposed transaction was notified under the Competition Act 2002, as amended, on 21 July 2025.

The Commission has formed the view that the proposed transaction will not substantially lessen competition in any market for goods or services in the State. The Commission will publish the reasons for its determination on its website no later than 60 working days after the date of the determination and after allowing the parties the opportunity to request that confidential information be removed from the published version.

Additional Information

Fidelity National Information Services, Inc. is a global provider of financial services technology, offering retail and institutional banking, payments, asset and wealth management, risk and compliance and outsourcing solutions.

Its provision of financial services technology has a focus on the supply of core IT solutions used to run banks and that underpin online banking. The supply of such IT solutions includes the licensing of software to banks including payments and other core banking functions, with vendor support. For issuers, it offers processing services for card transactions (predominantly prepaid and debit cards) as an adjacent function.

Total System Services LLC is Global Payments' payment solutions provider. It focuses primarily on the supply of card issuer processing services.
