Competition and Consumer Protection Commission clears proposed acquisition whereby CMNL Limited, trading as Celtic Media Group, would acquire sole control of the Tuam Herald.

The Competition and Consumer Protection Commission has today cleared the proposed transaction whereby CMNL Limited, trading as Celtic Media Group would acquire sole control of certain businesses and assets of The Herald Printing & Publishing Company Limited, specifically the Tuam Herald. The proposed transaction was notified under the Competition Act 2002, as amended, on 1 December 2025.

The Commission has formed the view that the proposed transaction will not substantially lessen competition in any market for goods or services in the State. The Commission will publish the reasons for its determination on its website no later than 60 working days after the date of the determination and after allowing the parties the opportunity to request that confidential information be removed from the published version.
