

MERGER ANNOUNCEMENT M/26/001 – APLEONA/TIM KELLY GROUP

Section 21 of the Competition Act 2002

Competition and Consumer Protection Commission clears proposed acquisition whereby Apleona Ireland Limited, would acquire sole control of Tim Kelly Mechanical Limited and Tim Kelly (Electrical Contractors) Limited.

The Competition and Consumer Protection Commission has cleared the proposed transaction whereby Apleona Ireland Limited, would acquire sole control of Tim Kelly Mechanical Limited and Tim Kelly (Electrical Contractors) Limited. The proposed transaction was notified under the Competition Act 2002, as amended, on 2 January 2026.

The Commission has formed the view that the proposed transaction will not substantially lessen competition in any market for goods or services in the State. The Commission will publish the reasons for its determination on its website no later than 60 working days after the date of the determination and after allowing the parties the opportunity to request that confidential information be removed from the published version.
