## Competition and Consumer Protection Commission clears proposed acquisition whereby Bridgepoint Group plc would acquire sole control of Interpath Group Limited

The Competition and Consumer Protection Commission has today cleared the proposed transaction whereby Bridgepoint Group plc, through Pathfinder Bidco Limited, would acquire sole control of Interpath Group Limited. The proposed transaction was notified under the Competition Act 2002, as amended, on 30 January 2026.

The Commission has formed the view that the proposed transaction will not substantially lessen competition in any market for goods or services in the State. The Commission will publish the reasons for its determination on its website no later than 60 working days after the date of the determination and after allowing the parties the opportunity to request that confidential information be removed from the published version.

### Additional Information

Bridgepoint is an international private assets investor active in private equity, infrastructure and private credit. It invests across sectors including advanced industrials, business & financial services, healthcare, and technology, and also operates an infrastructure platform focused on electricity and sustainability projects.

Pathfinder Bidco Limited is a private limited company incorporated under the laws of England and Wales for the sole purpose of acquiring Interpath Group Limited. Pathfinder Bidco Limited is indirectly majority-owned by entities within the Bridgepoint group.
